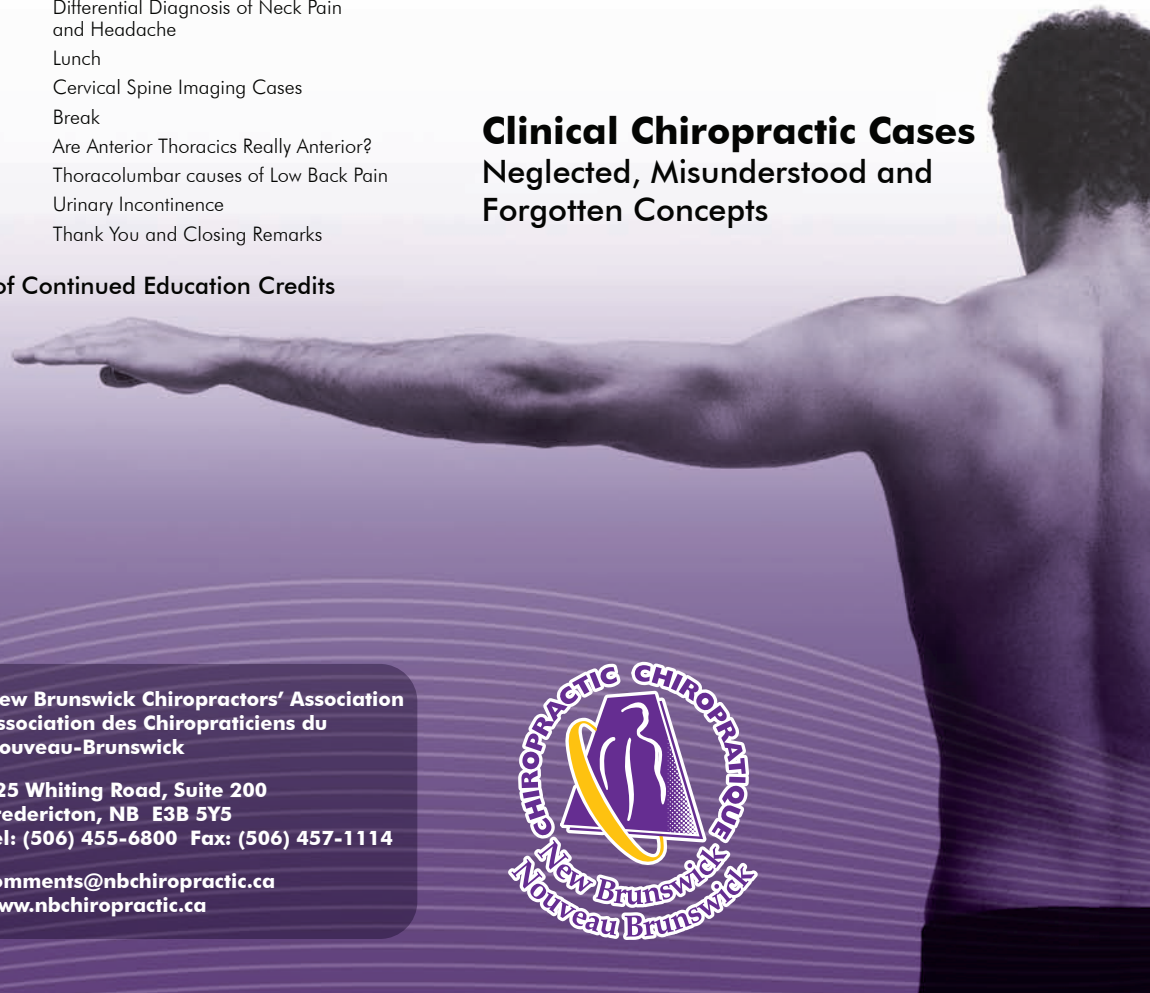

John A.M. Taylor graduated as a chiropractor in 1979 from CMCC in Toronto. He practiced in Vancouver, B.C., earned his diplomate in radiology from LACC, and completed a research fellowship in osteoradiology at the University of California, San Diego. He co-authored a textbook entitled Skeletal Imaging: Atlas of the Spine and Extremities, published by WB Saunders in 2000. He is the author of numerous articles in the chiropractic and biomedical literature and has lectured worldwide on the topic of diagnostic imaging in chiropractic. He is currently a professor of radiology in the chiropractic program at D'Youville College, Buffalo, NY.



Thomas F. Bergmann, D.C., F.I.C.C.
Professor, Methods Department
Northwestern Health Sciences University

Dr. Bergmann teaches in the chiropractic methods department and has been a faculty clinician, seeing patients in the faculty clinic at Northwestern Health Sciences University College of Chiropractic. Previously, he taught at the International College of Chiropractic which is now RMIT School of Chiropractic in Melbourne Australia. He is the founding editor of the peer-reviewed journal Chiropractic Technique and is on the editorial review board of Clinical Chiropractic. He is the co-author of two textbooks, Chiropractic Technique Principles and Procedures and Mechanically Assisted Manipulation The Distraction Techniques both by Mosby Publishing. Dr. Bergmann has also served as a consultant to Medicare and as a site team member for the Council on Chiropractic Education. He is a 1977 graduate of National College of Chiropractic.
